Location

In Stirling's historic old town just below Stirling Castle off the M9, Junction 10.

Venues

The Laigh Hall: Entered from the impressive courtyard, The Laigh Hall offers a unique and charming setting for wedding ceremonies.
Capacity: 60 people (ceremony).

The High Dining Room: Located on the first floor of the townhouse, this is the largest and grandest of the public rooms and provides an atmospheric venue for small wedding banquets.
Capacity: 30 people (reception).

Walled Garden and Courtyard: This private garden and impressive courtyard flanked by elaborate entrance gates is ideal for drink receptions.
Capacity: 120 people (reception).

Types of Ceremony

Religious and Humanist Wedding Ceremonies. Civil licences can be applied for from the local council.

Facilities

60 chairs for wedding ceremony. Furniture for dining for up to 30 on a long table.
